## Ring 1 Report by Sandy Weis et al.

On January 10th the Ring had its first meeting of the New Year with approximately twenty-five members in attendance. With inclement weather predicted, a few members decided not to brave the cold weather that we have been experiencing recently. Our meeting was scheduled to be a video night hosted by Steve Finkelstein. Steve, unfortunately, had a family emergency and was unable to attend. Steve Zuehlke jumped in at the last minute and did a teach in on the "Cups and Balls" and the "Hot Rod" routines. While most of the more seasoned members know the "ins and outs" of these effects, Steve's presentations were focused on showing the new members the workings of these two classic effects. Steve started out by showing the different styles of various cups that are on the market as well as a brief explanation of Rings N Things' history that was founded right here in St. Louis by our own Harry Monti and John Apperson. Steve did a basic "cup and ball" routine with explanations. Steve was assisted by member, Sandy Weis, and guest, Bonita M. Harmon. Steve then had both volunteers follow along with cups in hand as he proceeded to show just how easy this effect was to learn. Steve was nice enough to give both helpers their own set of cups and a magic wand. Both volunteers did an outstanding job and were quick studies as both performed the effect flawlessly with Steve's easy to follow instructions.

Next up was an explanation of the hot rod. Steve showed the basic paddle move stressing the "dos and don'ts" when executing the "move." Steve brought along an assortment of various hot rods, color changing knives, colored sticks, jumping gems, etc., showing the many different variations of this effect that all involve the paddle move. Afterwards, Mike McClure provided plastic paddles, complete with dry erase markers and stick on gems, so members had the chance to make their own "magic stick." It was great to see the different variations that other members perform. John Skarin bought his version of jumping gems and shared his great routine with several members of the group as well. Member Matthew Horowitz was fooled by the Hot Rod even though he owns the effect!

Trudy Monti was on hand selling copies of her new book entitled "My Magic Moments Journal." "My Magic Moments 2024 Journal" is a unique journal for both magicians and non-magicians to use in memorializing their thoughts, dreams, and plans, alongside historic events of magicians throughout the ages. Historic magic moments or events recorded for each day span 400+ years, with 700+ historic magic events regarding 600+ different magicians. Magicians will be reminded each day of those who went before them and helped to elevate their unique art form, AND non-magicians will experience a rare peek into a secret world of entertainment. Jill "Silly Jilly" Schmidt shared the following: "A year ago, I got a heartfelt message from Clownvis Presley, a singing clown with an Elvis twist. He inquired about Handy the Clown because "She did lots of parties for me and my friends when we were growing up in West County—St. Louis." I shared that Handy and I were friends and the sad news of Handy's passing in 2017. Clownvis replied, being "crushed to tears," and "She was my ultimate inspiration in everything I've ended up doing." Handy was portrayed by Sharon Cohen. Sharon was a Ring 1 member for many years and



loved attending the Midwest Magic Jubilees. Fast forward to December 22, 2023, when my husband and I attended Clownvis' concert at The Red Flag in St. Louis (see photo). Our main draw was knowing that my friend, Handy the Clown, had inspired him. The show was spectacular, mixing Elvis classics, Christmas songs, and Clownvis originals. Dan Todd shared the following—"Project Magic at Ranken Jorden Pediatric Bridge Hospital was cancelled in December and I have not scheduled Ring 1's 2024 visits to their facility yet. During January 2024, I performed on January 5th on the CCTV at St. Louis Children's Hospital. I will be performing parlor magic at Cardinal Glennon Children's Hospital on the 16th and closeup magic at Shriners Childrens Hospital on the 9th and 23rd. Interestingly Children's PAWS program added a playing cards deck with those lovable therapeutic dogs. They already had baseball type PAWS cards. I immediately made magic effects and it was easier with the playing cards than with the baseball style cards, since these have pips on the corners of the cards' faces with the dog's pictures and names in the center and matching backs naming Purina and St. Louis Children's Hospital on the cards. Children's Hospital has added a second day each week for me to teach and play chess with the patients." As you can see, even though Dan is retired, he is quite busy visiting these hospitals and sharing his magic skills with the children, their parents, and the staff. The Ring thanks Dan for all he does! (We just wish he was able to attend Ring 1's meetings. The members would really enjoy seeing all the magic effects he has created).

The 2024 St. Louis Kidney Walk takes place on March 24th at Westport Plaza. Several Ring 1 members volunteered last year and performed strolling magic. Steve Finkelstein, Ring 1's contact person, will provide details as soon as they are relayed to him. Members are encouraged to contact Steve if they are available.

Our members, Randy Kalin and Joshua Weidner, along with Jesse Bader and Christopher Barker, have created a group that perform together under the moniker "Disbelief." They have performed in Kansas, Illinois, Missouri and soon to be more locations. Each of them bring a different skill set to the group. Jesse Bader is an amazing film maker, Joshua Weidner uses his technology and detail skills to create magical mysteries, Randy Kalin uses his years of performing magic to tell stories using magic, and Christopher Barker uses his educational background to provide lessons to interested students. They are performing at various locations and these shows are usually sold out. Therefore, they are being asked by these venues to set a schedule for return visits. Escape - David Copperfield caused quite a stir in the magic world when he performed Timothy Wenk's "Misled" on television. Imagine passing a pen through a bill without any gaffs or gimmicks. KFC - This ingenious card fold will take the place of the standard Mercury Fold. Learn how to fold a card into quarters while the spectators are burning the deck. Best yet, they push their card into the center of the pack themselves.

D2D- Silver dollars are produced at your fingertips and then visually change into paper bills. The ultimate in eye candy!

Klinger - A modernized twist on a neo-classic effect of a (wand) pen clinging to your outstreached fingers. Both your hands and the pen may be examined. Quick preparation and a genuine fooler.

Audience Aces - A new approach to a classic. The spectators shuffle and cut the cards. Only to turn over the top cards to find the four aces.

Silkcoin 2.0 - A feature of my Magic Castle act in 2021. If you know the original, then you know how magical this looks. A single coin, a sheer scarf...just pure magic!
